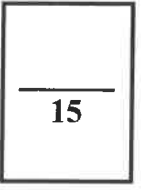

Leading a healthy lifestyle is important for all of us.

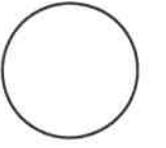
Plan and write a report of **two paragraphs** of not less than **(12 sentences)** about what you should and should not do to maintain a healthy lifestyle.
